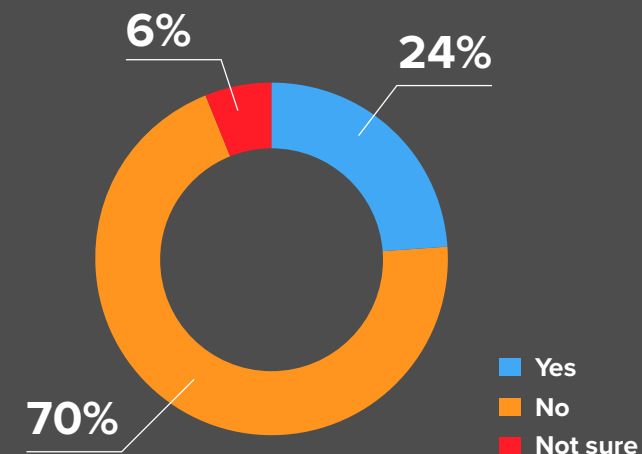


CBD-infused products continue to emerge, but what do U.S. consumers think?

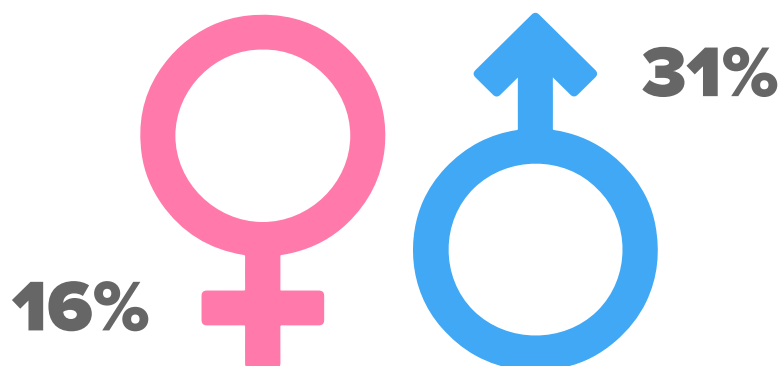
In the last five years, many U.S. adults' opinions towards marijuana legalization have largely evolved



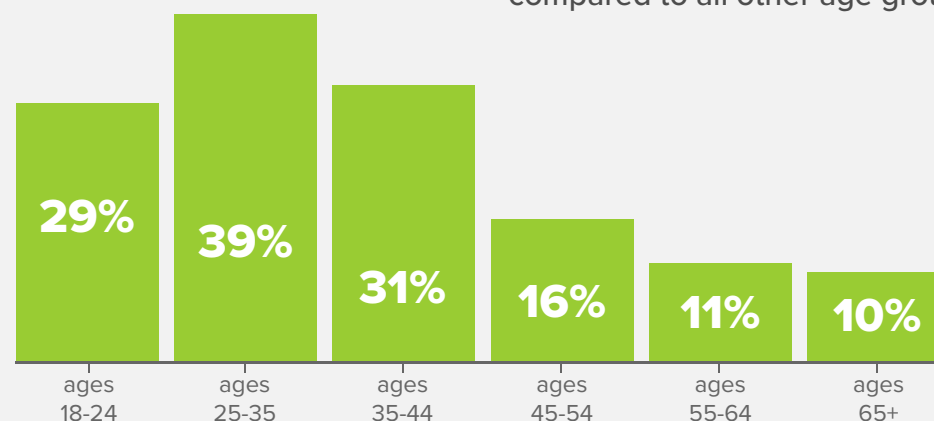
While 58% of consumers said they are familiar with CBD, only about one-fourth of total respondents said they've tried it



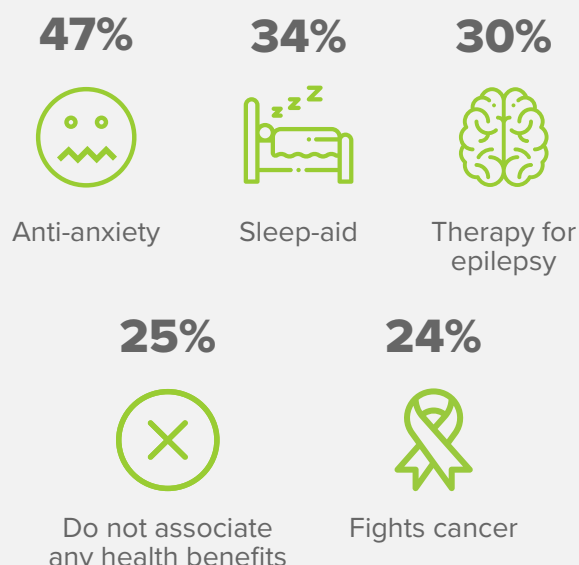
According to survey results, men were significantly more likely to try CBD than women



U.S. adults between the ages of 25 and 34 reported the highest level of CBD use compared to all other age groups



The most common health benefits associated with CBD were pain relief and anti-anxiety treatments
